There are numerous well qualified Funeral Homes in Colorado Springs, and we encourage individuals to do their research and select the Funeral Home that best meets the needs of the family. Prices should be verified with each funeral home and are updated regularly.

Information provided by each crematory service is for a basic **pre-paid direct cremation** that requires no memorial service, viewing, funeral home staff or reception. Pricing is based on the follow criteria:

- Pickup of deceased body (removal from place of death) and refrigeration.
- Contact next of kin to authorize cremation (required by law).
- Secure cremation permit.
- File for Death Certificate from Dept. of Public Health (\$20 for first, \$13 for each add.).
- Notify Social Security of death.
- Prepare confidential record of deceased's personal information.
- Interment vessel (each indicated a standard size is in use).
- Must provide dimensions provided by St. Michaels to the crematory.
- A family member is required to pick up remains from the crematory.
