From the Rector

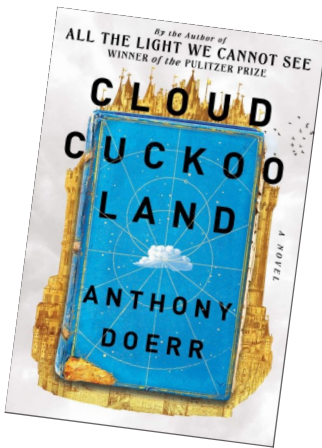
Updated COVID-19 Guidelines



In March we updated our Community Covenant that revised our policies on masks and Holy Eucharist. Masks indoors are now optional with the exception of our

nursery staff and volunteers. The common cup (or chalice) is back for dipping your Communion wafer into the wine (also known as *intinction*.) We continue to encourage all to exercise caution and stay home if you are sick or have any flu, cold, or COVID-19 symptoms. Color coded wrist bands are available in the Gathering Space to help provide others with a non-verbal communication about your comfortability level as it relates to interacting with others. We are aware our situation is evolving and if federal, state, county, and/or diocesan guidelines change we will update our Community Covenant as necessary. 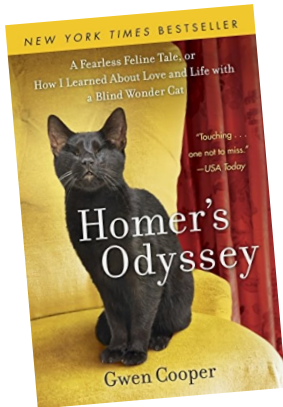

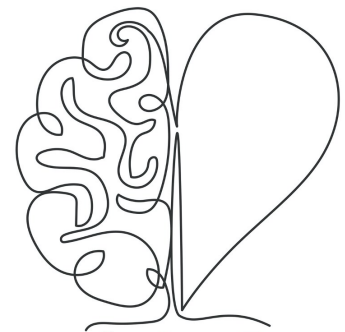

Outreach Committee reads *Toxic Charity*

Over the last five months, the Outreach Committee has been discussing the book *Toxic Charity* by Robert Lupton. Throughout his book, Lupton argues that we be thoughtful and particular about the ways in which we give our money and resources when it comes to charity. While Lupton is primarily focused on short-term missions and the problems that often arise when groups go on these trips, he also turns his attention to local giving. He argues that the Church must be better about the ways it helps the poor. That above all else our ministries must be dignifying, and work to break the cycles of poverty, rather than feed them. Each committee member who has participated has been invited to seriously think about one of the partner organizations, and whether they are helping or hurting those they are trying to protect most. As a continuation of this work, the Outreach Committee will be having a retreat on May 6-7. During this time they will get to know one another better, wrap up the book, and start to reconstruct a path forward through our own Biblical lens and tradition. The culmination of this retreat will be on May 9, when annual 2022 Outreach Grants will be awarded. We are grateful for their diligent work to think carefully about who God is calling us to be within and beyond our walls.
