## Don't forget a Wristband

When joining us for worship on Sundays or for weekday events, please wear a wristband to signal to others:

- **Green Wristband** : indicates you are comfortable with handshakes and hugs.
- **Yellow Wristband** : indicates you are being cautious and prefer to greet others with a elbow bump or fist bump.
- **Red Wristband** : indicates you prefer to greet from six feet. We ask that those wearing a red wristband to also wear a face mask at all times.



## Masks

Regardless of vaccination status - all individuals over the age of 2 must wear a mask **while inside** at St. Michael's, until further notice. If you forget your mask we have adult and children sizes available in the Gathering Space. Masks are not required if your group is meeting outdoors or if you are inside and in a room or space by yourself. Please be mindful of physical distancing and stop by the hand sanitizing station when you enter the building. Thank you!

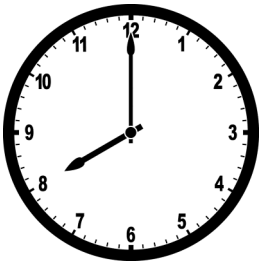
## Worshiping in a Pandemic ...

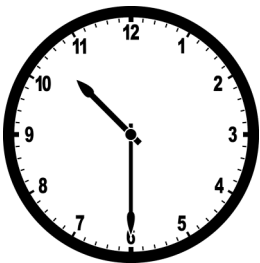
## About the new (familiar) Sunday Services : **Beginning Sept.19**

### 8:00 AM Holy Eucharist



The 8:00 AM Worship Service will be a traditional Rite II Episcopal liturgy with prayers, scripture readings, several music pieces, a sermon, and the Holy Eucharist. The service will be livestreamed on St. Michael's social media accounts (YouTube, Facebook, and Vimeo) for you to watch live or later in the day or week. The 8:00 AM Service will last approximately an hour. Face masks are required when worshiping indoors except when receiving Communion. Coffee hour will follow the 8:00 AM service.

### 10:30 AM Holy Eucharist



The 10:30 AM Worship service will be held outdoors on the plaza and back lawn, weather permitting. The order of service will be similar to the 8:00 AM traditional Rite II liturgy with more music and a Children's Chapel experience during the first part of the service for 4-year-olds to 5th graders. In the event of inclement weather, the 10:30 AM service will move inside the church with masks required for all 2-years-old and older. Coffee hour will follow the 10:30 AM service.

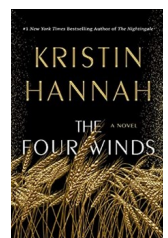

## The Colorado House Snack and Supplemental Food Ministry

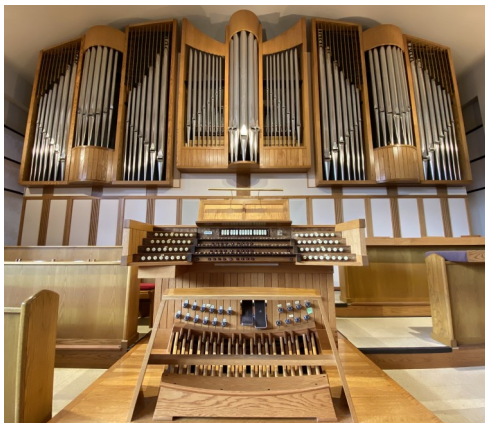
